Hello, my friends!

"Take the Church, to the People--Take the Church, to the People!" Over 500 participants in the Unite Atlanta project roared back enthusiastically as Whirlwind Missions prepared to host outreach events in **20 apartment complexes simultaneously**. Together with more than **30 partnering churches** we had service projects in **5 apartment complexes and 25 public schools, job and health fairs at the mall and in the community**.

The following week was the multi-church celebration where Governor Purdue of Georgia along with several state representatives came to thank us personally for our work. Over 5,000 volunteers participated in the largest single weekend of outreach in Georgia's history. Thirty thousand people in metro Atlanta witnessed Jesus people in motion!

There are two kinds of army. *Regular Army* where you have thousands of people, with tons of supplies, behind an impenetrable fortress. Then you have *Special Forces*--light fire teams of 8 people dropped off *behind enemy lines*. This was an incredible melding of the two concepts. As I witnessed the hundreds of people taking the church directly into their communities, I realized just how big a change Christians can bring into our society.

And there's plenty to change. Two weeks ago I read a report in the newspaper of a double shooting resulting in a homicide in Oaktree. Perhaps you remember that name--it's one of our newest missions! I went to the apartment manager's meeting for that area last week. The Lieutenant for the Central DeKalb district was there.

"You're crazy working there, Tim. Most of the folks at that complex are carrying weapons," he insisted.

One of the other managers called me aside. "Tim, the Lieutenant is right. It's too dangerous for you to be there."

"Sandy," I told her, "I only work at complexes that have problems. God will protect us." She didn't look so sure. My partner looked at me and nodded with confidence. When you work for the King there are risks involved. The only safe place is in His hands!

We are involved in the largest spiritual war ever to face mankind. More clergy is not the answer. Regular front-line troops are the solution. I love the saying, "An army of one." We are fighting for our King, in the only battle of eternal significance. This is not a "Tim" thing or "My Preacher" thing---this is a JESUS thing. Unless each of us takes up their swords and gets personally involved we will not win this battle. Thank you for helping our team lead the charge against the front lines of enemy territory. We can't do it without your support! Give thanks for HE is good!
