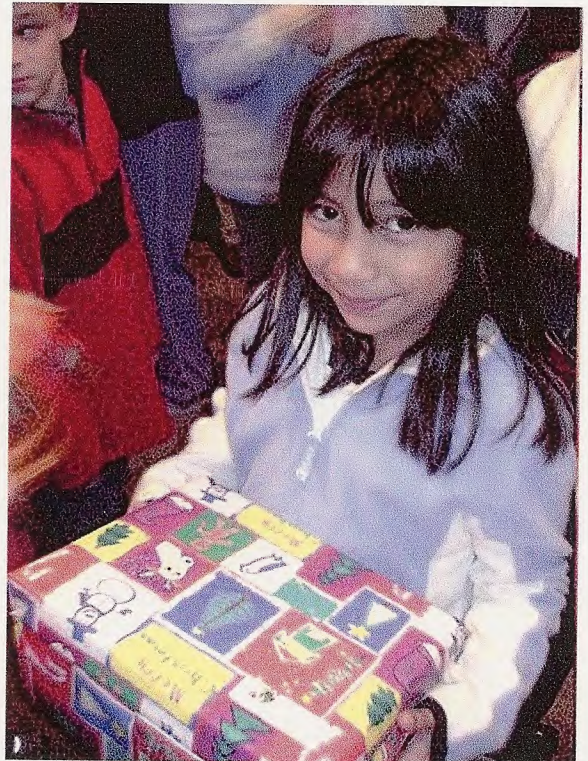
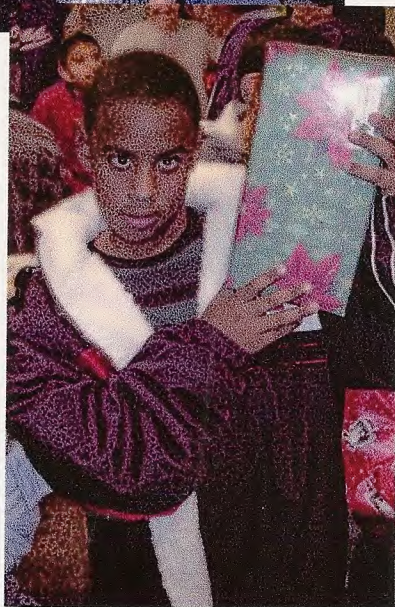
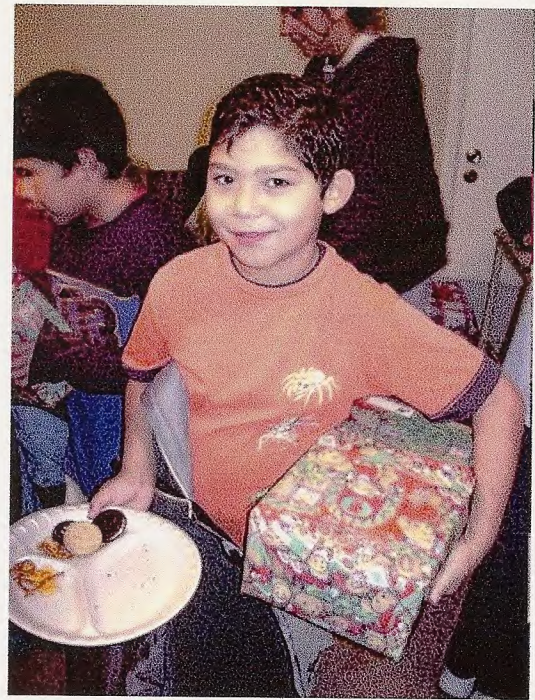
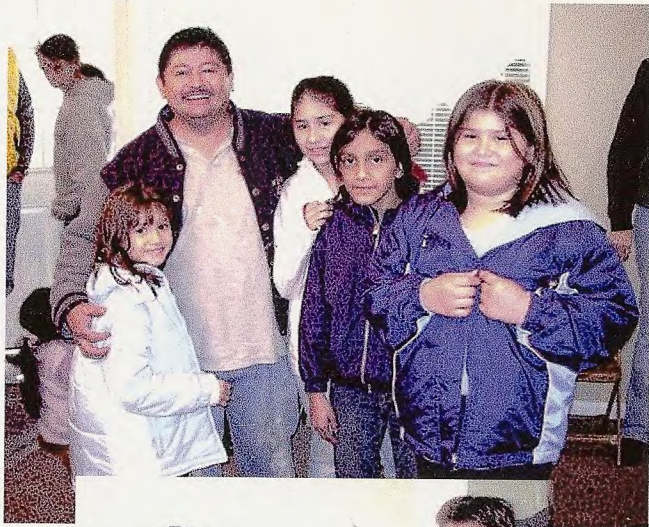




Annual Report—2004

- Over 271 men, women and children from Buddhist, Hindu, Muslim and Catholic backgrounds have accepted Christ as their personal savior this year.
- Over 4,200 volunteers have come through our missions.
- We have regular work in 32 locations in Roswell, Norcross, Tucker, Duluth, Chamblee, Doraville, Clarkston, Lawrenceville, Avondale Estates, Conyers, Austell and DeKalb/Gwinnett Counties.
- Tim was named "Missionary of the Year" by the North American Mission Board.
- We hosted over 120 different church groups this Summer. We handled the logistics for the Merge, World Changers, Disciple Now and Gold Rush programs.
- We worked in 31 different apartment complexes this summer.
- Some of our new partners include Johnson Ferry Baptist Church, Atlanta Vineyard, Sugarloaf Community Church, Church of the Apostles, Hebron Baptist Church, Grace Church and Atlanta Chinese Christian Church North.
- We offer after-school, English as second language, computer and resume classes, recreation and feeding programs, and Outreach Events.
- Updated our website. We now have three sister sites which include Mission information, over 8,000 pictures in our Photo Gallery as well as a daily Journal.
- Represented Whirlwind Missions at mission conferences at Grace Fellowship, FBC Atlanta, Macedonia-Midway BC, Perimeter Church, Peachtree Corners Baptist Church and FBC Conyers.
- Complete set of Maps/Directions/Contacts on the web site including a virtual tour of each location. Our website is the model for America.
- Started new work at Saddlebrook, Southern Woods, Southern Trace, Kensington Manor, Glennbrooke, Las Colinas, the Ambers, The Lakes, Woodside, Herrington Creek and Southern Pines. Re-started work at Northchase. We are sponsoring on site missionaries at Huntington Ridge, Southern Trace, The Corners and Huntington Terraces. We also had on site missionaries at Azalea during the Summer.
- We instituted our Frontliners program for short-term missionaries.
- We developed our training material for starting and supporting mission work in apartment complexes.
- Hosted construction projects at FBC Doraville. Our teams installed new tile, new lights, painted, and remodeled.
- Distributed food at Thanksgiving, toys for Christmas and school supplies to over 400 kids in Chamblee, Doraville, Norcross, Duluth, Clarkston and Marietta.
