

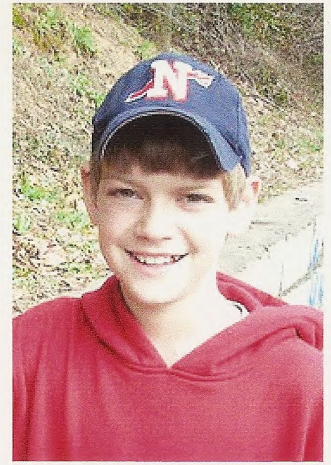
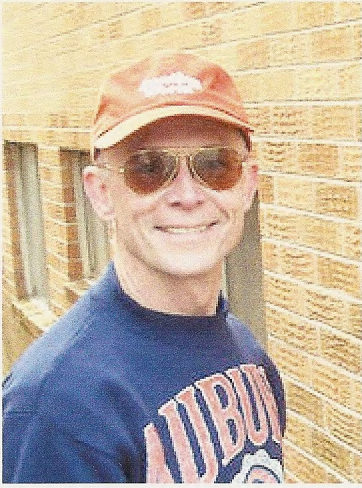

"No problem!"

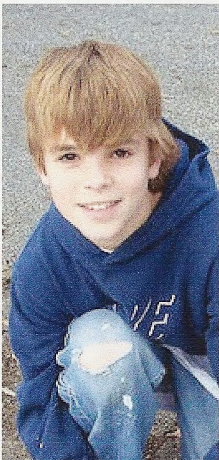

"I work with local churches in the area. I'm setting up an after school program so we can reach the kids in the neighborhood for Christ." I explained.

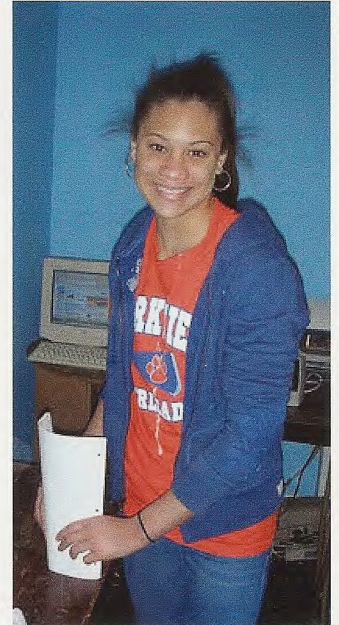
"I go to Victory World Church. I've been praying that someone would come and help us!"

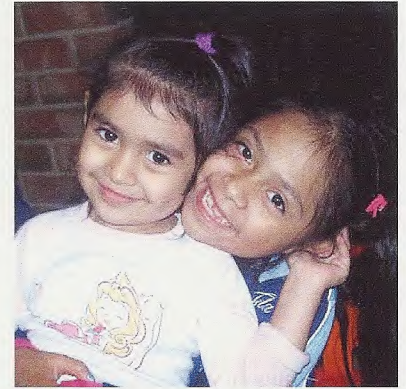

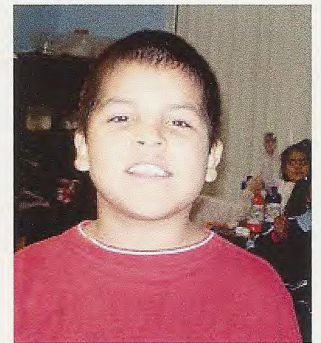
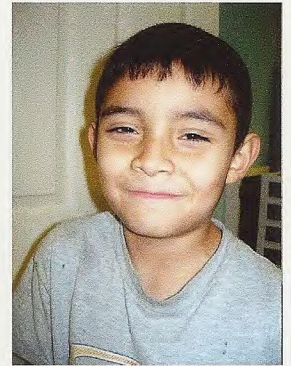
