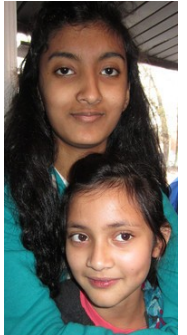
When the story of Christmas was complete, I asked them a few questions. “What is Christmas about?”
