Begin with outline of pumpkin.



Fill in with Orange.



Add eyes and nose in Black.



Add Jack-O-Lantern mouth in Black.



Add Green stem and leaf.



Outline ghost in White. Fill in.



Add eyes, mouth and glitter for fun.



Begin with Yellow base...



...Then Orange ...



... then White. Cute paired up with the pumpkin.



There are so many variations of butterflies and simple or complicated, they are all beautiful. Two yellow wings set the shape.



Add body in Green or your color choice.



I separated the wings for highlight colors; this is optional.



Highlight in bright blue.



Add Blue quadrant.



Add Green quadrant.



End with Red quadrant.



Use a dark color for the tail string.



Begin with Yellow cupcake 'holder'.



Add Brown for chocolate cupcake or White for vanilla cupcake.



Add your favorite icing color.



A white candle and yellow 'flame'.



Finally, add embellishments and "sprinkles".



Begin with brown cone. I mixed the brown a bit with black to achieve a darker cone color.



Add one scoop of ice cream in your favorite color.



Add a second scoop on top.



Finally, embellish with whipped cream, a cherry and a few ice cream 'drips.'



Begin with an outline of the rose in Red.



Fill in with solid color.



Add a few squiggles in



Add Green leaves.



Outline in Black. This is a bold and stunning look, particularly for older kids and adults.



Begin with a White rectangle.



Add a Red cone and Red accent stripes



Add Green accents.



Create flames by first painting elongated teardrops in Yellow. Follow on top with a stroke of Orange.\




Begin with Yellow dots for flower centers




Add flower petals on at of your choice.




Finish with Green stems, and a 'lawn' of grass.



Begin with light White outline of flag shape.



Paint White stripes.



Follow with Red Stripes.



Fill in star box with solid Blue.



"Dot" on White stars.



Paint airplane body in Green.



Add wings in Blue.



The window areas are painted with Red.



Dot on individual windows in White.



Wing accent is painted in Black.

# HOW TO MAKE BALLOON ANIMALS!



Start off by pumping up your balloon. You can get a pump for about \$5 and 144 balloons for \$10 from Party City or any party supply store.



Make sure to leave some space at the end. This way the air has some where to go and won't pop!

Tie the balloon by wrapping the end around your pointer and middle fingers and then pull the end through to make a knot.



Hold the balloon with one hand and twist it around about 5 times with the other hand. You're making a bubble about the size of four fingers. Hold it tight so it doesn't come undone! Do this until you have 3 small bubbles.



Now fold the balloon in half



... and twist the two joints together.



You now have the head of the dog!



Twist three more bubbles just like you did in the first steps.



Twist the joints of the first two bubbles together. These are the front legs of the dog.





Next, twist and make one long bubble



...and three more smaller bubbles.



Twist the last two bubble sections together at the joints. These are the rear legs of the dog.



The left over part of the balloon is the tail.



You did it! Now give it to one VERY happy kid!

You can't make a mistake with the forms really---it just takes creativity on your part! For instance, if the front two parts are really big you have a rabbit. If the body is really long you have a sausage dog. Long rear legs is a rabbit. A long neck is a giraffe. Long tail is a kangaroo! Have fun!!
