Hello, my friends!

April was a wonderful month for Whirlwind Missions! Our Spring Break teams did a super job! We shared the good news of Jesus with hundreds of children and adults! Every morning I meet with the team and give them a briefing on what we're going to see in the International Village. On Wednesdays, I talk to them about Hinduism and Islam, two of the world's largest religions. After the briefing, we visit a Hindu temple and a N. African grocery store, Madina. The owner of Madina is a good friend of mine named Abdul. He has hosted thousands of kids to his store. Abdul is a leader at the local mosque. His store has a large library of Islamic books, CDs and DVDs, many on how to talk to Christians about Islam!

"Thank you so much, Abdul for welcoming us to your store!" I gave Abdul a hug.

"It's great to see you again, Tim!"

"These young people want to know more about Islam. What would you say is the most important thing they could learn, Abdul?"

"Islam is not a religion! It is a proces for living life in a holy way."

"What do you mean?"

"We have a way of holiness. It is important that your food is killed properly, and that you dress properly."

"Like Kosher food?"

"Yes. The animal must be killed with a knife so that the blood escapes. And you must cover the beauty parts of the body."

Abdul pointed towards the shawls that the women wear.

"Some Americans believe that all Muslims are terrorists. What do you say to that?"

"There are good Christians and bad Christians. Just as there are good Muslims and bad Muslims. Mohammed said that we should live in peace and not kill. When these terrorists kill people in the name of Allah, that is very bad. They will be punished for their actions very severely."

"What do Muslims think about Jesus?"

"We call Jesus, 'Isah'." He was a very holy man and a prophet. We consider him one of our prophets."

"So do you think that Jesus was God?"

Abdul shook his head slowly, "No. Jesus was a very good man. But he was not God. There is only one God."

"Do you believe that he was crucified on the cross?"

"No. Allah made a perfect substitute for Jesus. He looked just like Jesus, but he was not Jesus. At the end of Jesus' ministry, God took him straight up into heaven."

"Thank you, Abdul for you time. We really appreciate it!" I shook Abdul's hand firmly and told the kids, "Go upstairs and you can see the prayer room that people use.


