We also had a great time at the basketball camp this weekend. Five of our Muslim children accepted Christ! Praise the LORD!

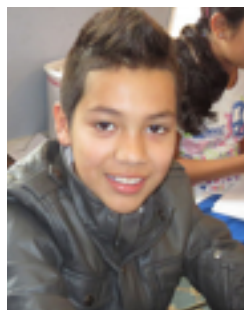
Thank you for all your prayers. It's not a strategy but THE strategy and I see God at work here in the International Village.
