The boy cocked his head and looked up at me. Eyes pinched together in disbelief. "So it's ok to learn about Isa?"

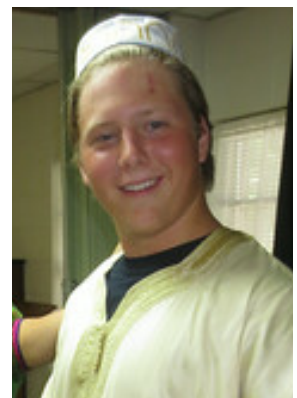
"Yes!"

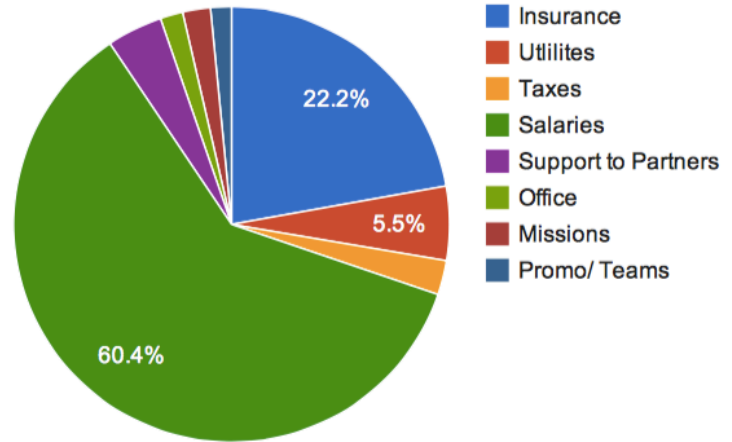
