At one site there was a little Hispanic girl being held by one of our team members. The two played together, chasing each other up and down the slide. After two hours they seemed like long lost friends.

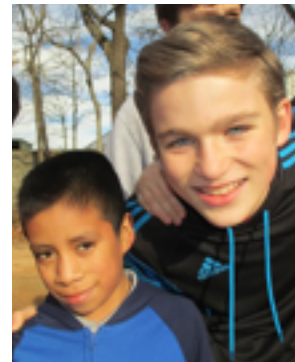
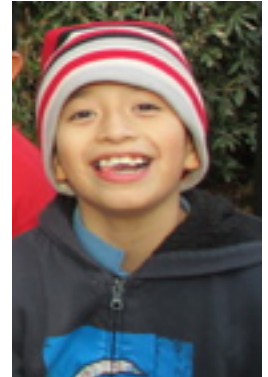
Then it was time to pack up. The little girl clung to our member. Huge tears rolled down her cheeks.
