Hah! We both laughed.

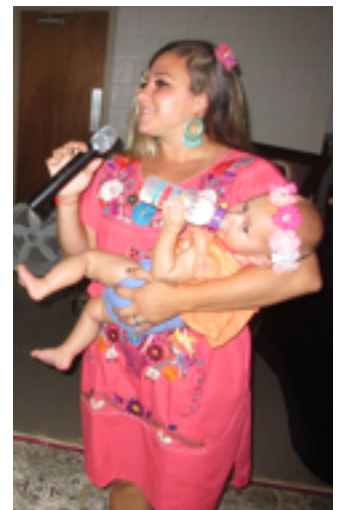
