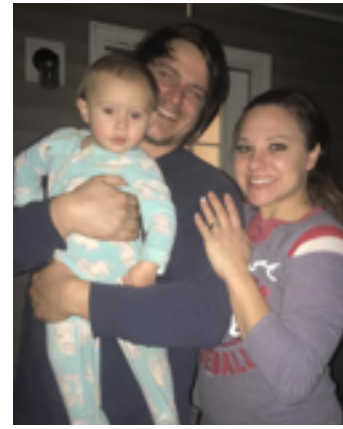




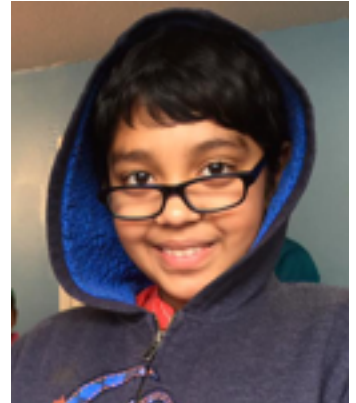
## Letters from the Mission Field February 2017

It's like Dad always says, "The Evil One always hits us at our weakest link."

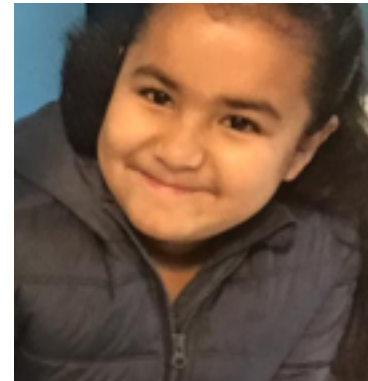


For me it's P. I'd much rather be the one suffering than to see her with the runny nose and bright red cheeks.

This year our insurance bills reach \$43,080!

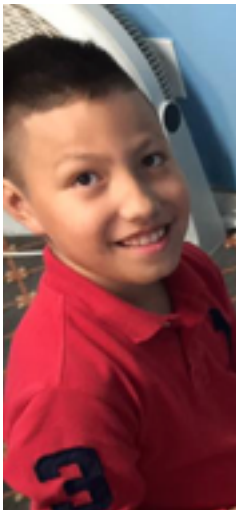
With out this liability we can't do our ministry.
