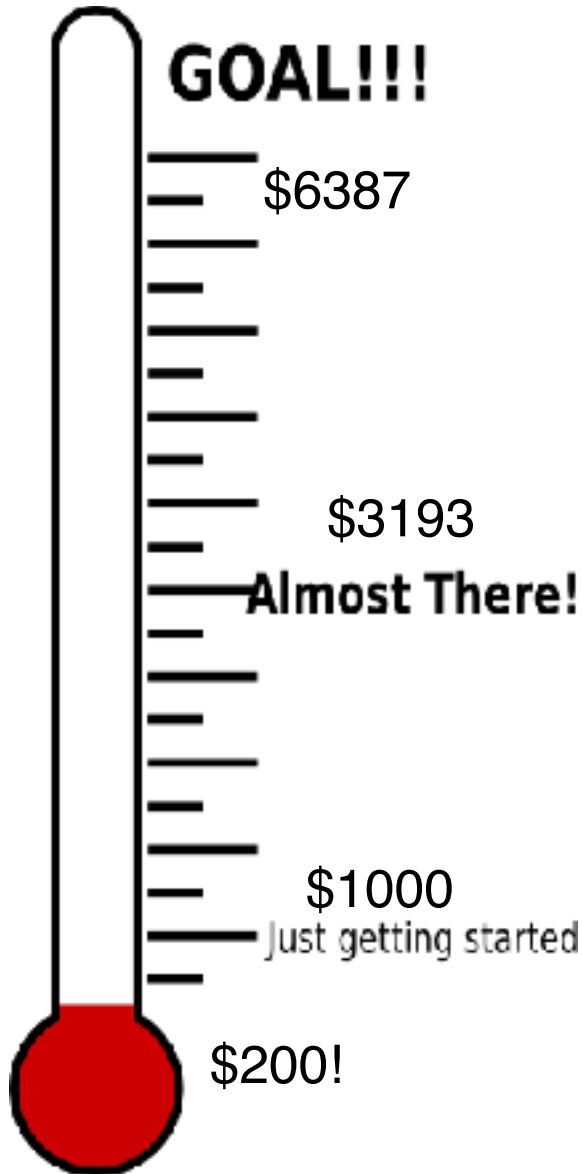
Please be praying for beautiful weather and divine appointments to be met.
